





CAST Sixth Form is a high performing, firmly established sixth form with a strong track record of both academic excellence and student progress.






## **Teaching**

## Challenge

Throughout the sixth form students engage in extended STEM projects developed and delivered collaboration with industry, health care and academia. Students can choose projects from biomedical, computer science, engineering, physics, chemistry, and ecology. The projects are interdisciplinary and mirror skills needed in the future. They are particularly helpful in allowing students to try out areas of study that they may want to continue with in the future.





### Student support

All students have a form tutor who supports their wider development. Through our tutor program students develop their study skills and learn about the wider aspects of PSHE and SMSC. The college provides strong SEND support and has a dedicated pastoral team who are able to provide outstanding support if required.
