## Student Testing w/c 8<sup>th</sup> March

- Students arriving on site will make their way to the College Gym through the side gate by the tennis courts. There they will be registered and given instructions on how to administer their test.

- Following the test, students should go home immediately while following the current regulations about social distancing and travel.
- Students will only be able to be tested if the parental consent form has been completed.
- Students <u>will not</u> need to wear school uniform for this test but should ensure they are wearing warm clothing.
- In the event that a student tests positive while still at College, they will not be allowed to return home on the school bus and will be isolated on site. We will contact the student's parents/carers who will need to collect the student from school as soon as practically possible.

## **Remote Learning**

We appreciate that there will be disruption to learning for the week of March 8<sup>th</sup> as students attend College for their tests. Staff will ensure the work on teams is accessible for independent work that can be completed at a later time so students continue to receive a high quality offer but are not disadvantaged by attending their testing slot.

## **Vulnerable Students and Children of Keyworkers Provision**

The College will continue to be open to vulnerable students and the children of key workers during this week. Buses/ taxis will continue as they have been during the lockdown period.

## Week Commencing 15<sup>th</sup> March

- All students in each year group will be required to attend school as usual from this date
- The buses will be fully operational
- The canteen will be open to students. Designated time slots specific to Year groups will be given to help ensure social distancing
- Students will be expected to wear masks in classrooms and corridors unless they are exempt. They are not expected to wear masks outside or during certain physical activities such as PE or dance.
