APPLICATION PROCESS

SEPTEMBER 2024



Our September 2024 applications open on 1st October 2023.

Those who apply by the published deadline and meet our admissions criteria, are invited to attend an Advice and Guidance Meeting in February, where course choices, hobbies outside of education and future goals are discussed.

Once a study programme is agreed on, a conditional offer is sent to the student's online application.

SPORT AND ENRICHMENT

On-campus indoor and outdoor sports facilities, including our student gym, are available to all Long Road students.

There is also a wide range of student-led clubs and societies to get involved in such as: Duke of Edinburgh, Pride, Volunteering and many more.

We also offer the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) as an option to students in their first year of study. As an independent research project, it is extremely popular with universities and employers.

Aspiring medics can join our bespoke Med Squad programme, working closely with University of Cambridge medical students as they help our students prepare for Medical School.



STUDENT SUPPORT



Our teaching and support staff all have a strong commitment to ensuring that everyone has equal opportunities to succeed.

We have a wide range of services available to all students to support your needs; whether they're academic, practical or emotional. For students with EHC plans, we develop individual learning programmes that are regularly reviewed and adjusted as needed. Students with English as their second language are offered extra tuition with a specialist teacher.

A range of IT equipment and software is available to support students' studies. All our buildings have ready access for wheelchair users, and we provide classroom and general assistance for students who have physical impairments.
